Today, over 30 years later, the Corner Cupboard feeds nearly 2,500 people every month, through a network of 11 pantries throughout the country.

With the dedication of 4 full-time staff members, 14 pantry coordinators, 9 board members, and over 150 volunteers, the Corner Cupboard is truly a community effort of "Neighbors Helping Neighbors".
